



#### **Interstate Weight Limits**

- 20 K pounds a single axle
- 34 K pounds on a tandem axle
- 80 K pounds on 5 axles with a 51 feet minimum distance from the center of the first axle to the center of axle 5.
- Federal Bridge formula weight limit compliance on other axle configurations.
- Overweight vehicles may be required to get legal to continue.






# State Highway Weight Limits 63-5-27 (4c)

- Vehicles designed and constructed to collect and transport solid waste...
- Not conform to the axle spacing or tire loading
- Limited to 60 k pounds gross weight
- Limited to the gross vehicle weight rating
- Operated within 50 miles radius of home base or contractual customer.
- All wheels brake-equipped
- No interstate travel, or posted roadways or bridges.





















### **County Bridge Status Access**

- Approximately 2000 county bridges are posted or closed.
- Important to be aware of these restrictions
- The list changes daily

- Remember-school buses, fire trucks, and our families travel across bridges every day.




















#### **Out of State Trucks**

- Must be have apportioned license plates from home state
- If not apportioned must have three day Trip permit
- Must buy fuel in Mississippi and retain receipts
- Must have a valid CDL and insurance
- Violations could delay delivery of products or increase round trip times
