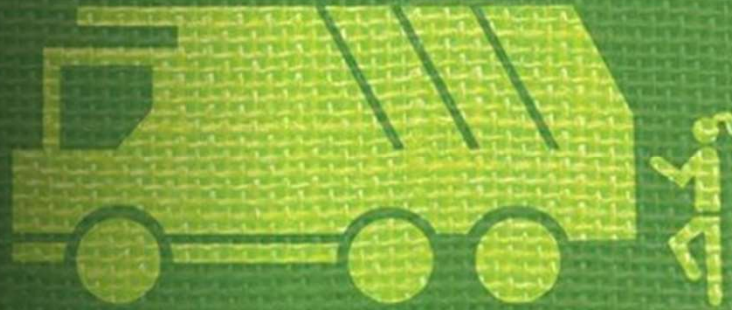

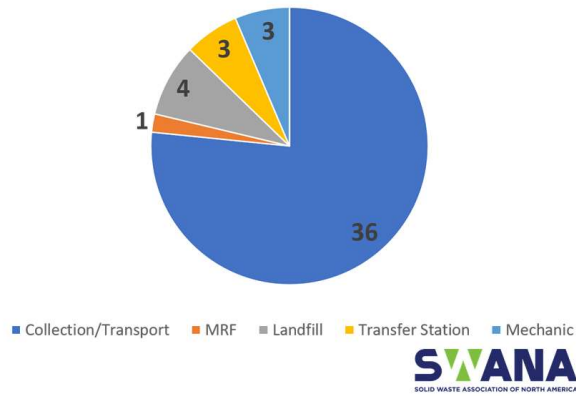

2020 SWANA Fatality Report

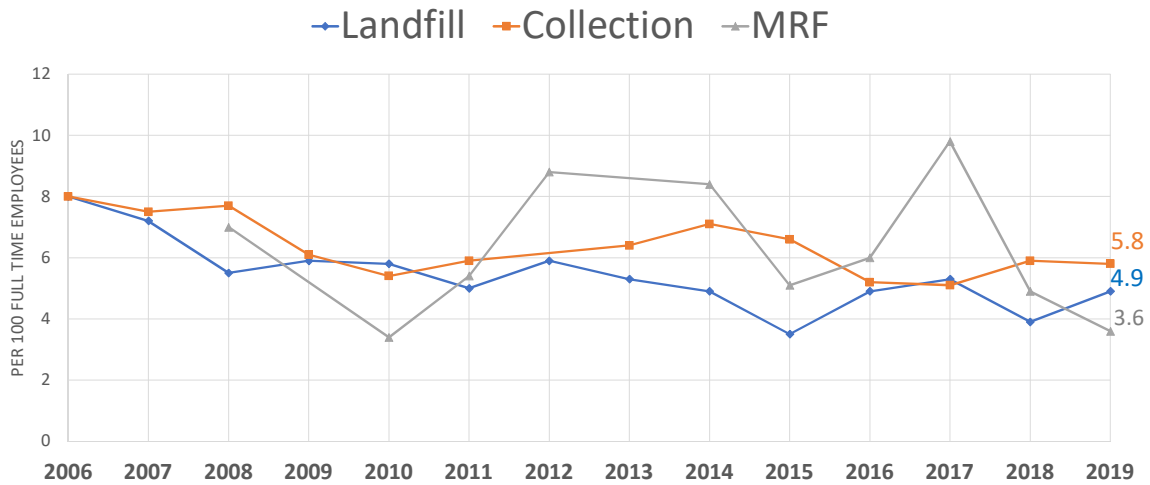
52 MSW Workers Died in 2020

- 70% occurred during collection
- Most common events were:
 - single vehicle accidents
 - struck by waste vehicle
- 53 workers died in 2019
